







NEIGHBORHOOD PLAZA FROM WHITTIER STREET

A Vibrant Public Realm:

- Knitted into traditional, humanscaled Roxbury fabric
- Complete, balanced streets that serve all users
- Permeability across site
- Open space integrated into site, centrally located, with areas of shade, sun & seating for pedestrian comfort
- Active uses and transparency along public street frontages
- Step down in scale towards Whittier neighborhood

TREMONT ST. GATEWAY, LOOKING DOWN VERNON ST.

Transformation to an Inviting Frontage:

- Ground floor active uses, high transparency facades
- Streets and paths for access through site
- Vernon traffic-calmed as woonerf to balance traffic and pedestrian amenities



Our Proposed Building Heights: 30' -165'


Ground Floor Plan

Job Creation & Training



- Construction Jobs
 - 1,600 jobs created
 - \$336.4 M total paid in wages
 - \$90/ hour average wage (incl. benefits)
- Prioritize opportunities for Boston residents, women, and minority individuals and subcontracts in hiring and bidding practices.
- Work with trade schools and programs, including Madison Park Technical Vocational High School to provide exposure and training to the various building trades.
- Encourage subcontracts to provide apprentice and pre-apprentice opportunities to students and Boston residents




LabCentral Ignite will Provide Training for Local Students and Workers, Make Life Sciences Accessible for All
